# Permits for the State of California



Q2 2025 Report

One of the many services that the California Film Commission offers is film & photography permitting for state-owned and operated locations which include 280 State Parks & Beaches, 145 Buildings & Facilities, as well as 257 state & federal highways.

During the second quarter of 2025, California state properties and highways hosted a total of 673 Shoot Days, a boost of 3.2% compared to Q2 2024's 652 Shoot Days. Television saw a decline of -31.9% with 32 Shoot Days compared to 47 days the year prior. Commercial productions totaled 92 Shoot Days in Q2 2025, down -8.9%, compared to 101 Shoot Days in the same period of 2024. Feature Film Shoot Days fell to 35, or -68.8%, compared to 112 in the previous year's Q2.

The Other category within this report, which includes Photography, Documentary, Music Video, Short Film & Student Film productions, had Shoot Days in Q2 2025 increase to 514 compared to 392 Shoot Days in Q2 2024, or 31.1% higher.




#### 2024 – 2025 Q2 Total Shoot Days




Vs. 5 Year Average: +28.4%


















## Permits Issued by Category in Q2 2025








## Shoot Days by Category in Q2 2025
