Q1 2025 Report

One of the many services that the California Film Commission offers is film & photography permitting for state-owned and operated locations which include 280 State Parks & Beaches, 145 Buildings & Facilities, as well as 257 state & federal highways.

During the first quarter of 2025, California state properties and highways hosted a total of 560 Shoot Days, a decline of 12.9% compared to Q1 2024's 643 Shoot Days. Television saw a growth of 142% with 121 Shoot Days compared to 50 days the year prior. Commercial productions accrued 116 Shoot Days in Q1 2025, up 30.3%, compared to 89 Shoot Days in the same period of 2024. Feature Film Shoot Days fell to 26, or -69.8%, compared to 86 in the previous year's Q1.


The Other category within this report, which includes Photography, Documentary, Music Video, Short Film & Student Film productions, had Shoot Days in Q1 2025 decrease to 297 compared to 418 Shoot Days in Q1 2024, a decline of 28.9%.

Vs. Q1 2024: -12.9%





















Permits Issued by Category in Q1 2025



■ Buildings/Facilities □ Caltrans ■ State Parks




Shoot Days by Category in Q1 2025
